NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that an election for seats on the Middle Rio Grande Conservancy District (MRGCD) Board of Directors will be held on Tuesday, June 4, 2019. The purpose of the election is to elect Directors for the Board of Directors for the following positions: : Position No. 1 – Director At-Large, Position No. 2 – Director for Bernalillo County, & Position No. 5 – Director for Valencia County.

QUALIFIED ELECTOR REQUIREMENTS: As per [§73-14-20(G) NMSA 1978 Comp as amended], “qualified elector” means an individual who owns real property within the benefited area of the MRGCD and who has provided proof of ownership interest to one of the sources specified in Subsection B of Section 73-14-20.1 NMSA 1978 within the required time period or who resides on and owns legal or equitable title in Tribal Lands and who is over the age of majority. You do not have to be an irrigator to qualify to vote. A qualified elector may vote at any polling location within the four counties of the MRGCD.

There is not a formal registration process to vote in the MRGCD election. If you own property within the MRGCD benefited area and you have a recorded deed with the county and your individual name is listed on the deed, you are already registered. While county registration is not a requirement for voting in the MRGCD election, qualified elector names shall be obtained from the records of the County Clerk and Assessor of the appropriate county, records of the MRGCD and the enrollment records provided by the six Middle Rio Grande Pueblos. An individual who purchases property ninety (90) days prior to an election (March 6, 2019) and whose name does not appear on the qualified elector’s list will be able to vote on a Provisional Ballot. This voter must bring proof of property ownership to the MRGCD office at 1931 Second Street SW, Albuquerque before 4:00 p.m. Thursday, June 6, 2019 or the Provisional Ballot will not be counted. An individual may become certified to vote in a future election by filing his deed of title with the appropriate County Clerk at least ninety (90) days before the next MRGCD election [Sec. 73-14-20.1 NMSA 1978].

ABSENTEE VOTING: Any qualified elector may vote by absentee ballot beginning April 25, 2019 through Saturday, June 1, 2019. Applications for absentee ballots may be requested by e-mail from Automated Election Services mrqcd@electionpeople.com the MRGCD website www.mrqcd.com or at one of the following locations:
