  - 1) Spring Operational Goals Based on Water Supply Diversions for charging will be staggered in March to leave approximately 50% of the baseflow in the river in order to provide Compact deliveries as well as providing irrigation deliveries for early crops starting the week of March 21 for Socorro Division and March 28 for the Belen Division. The Albuquerque and Cochiti Divisions will be targeted for irrigation deliveries starting the weeks of April 4 and April 11. Mature crops will be scheduled beginning in early April until all fields receive the first irrigation then scheduling on the rotational plan will begin and continue for as long as water is available above the prior and paramount flow for the Pueblos.
  - 2) Fall End Date The District may run until October 15 to provide for fall planting but will be highly contingent upon water availability and the need to re-connect the river for efficient deliveries to Elephant Butte as the season ends and the winter delivery period begins.
