Technical Assistance

- <u>Community Soil Health Lab and Dynamic Soil Survey Program:</u> Schedule a site visit with our new soil scientist/ agroecologist to test your soils or develop a soil and irrigation management plan for the next growing season. Email Gabby Coughlin for more information.
- In partnership with the Village of Los Ranchos Agri-Nature Center, landowners in the Middle Rio Grande Valley will have access to a soils lab that will provide many services beginning in 2022.



Financial Assistance

- <u>Emergency Fallowing and Environmental Water Leasing Program</u>: Leasing payments are available to eligible irrigators to help reduce demand on water supplies. **Enrollment ends March 25, 2022.** Contact Casey Ish for more information.
- **<u>Regional Conservation Partnership Program</u>**: If you're in the South Valley in Bernalillo County, or in Valencia or Socorro Counties, you could be eligible for this 5-year program. The estimated program start is Fall 2022. The first step to applying is to have a USDA-Farm Service Agency Farm and Tract number established. Contact Gabby Coughlin for more information
