



## DECLARATION OF EMERGENCY PURCHASE

The Middle Rio Grande Conservancy District, hereby notifies of the conduction of an "Emergency Procurement" pursuant to § 13-1-127 NMSA 1978

The emergency procurement method (NMSA 1978, Section 13-1-127 may only be used when there exists a threat to public health, welfare, safety or property requiring procurement under emergency conditions. The existence of the emergency condition creates an immediate and serious need for services, construction or items of tangible personal property that cannot be met through normal procurement methods and the lack of which would seriously threaten:

1. The functioning of government;
2. The preservation or protection of property;
3. or the health or safety of any person

**DESCRIPTION OF SERVICES OR TANGIBLE PERSONAL PROPERTY:**

Asphalt Millings, Rip Rap 12" to 18", various gravel and dirt, and Transport Hauling

**JUSTIFICATION:**

Due to unprecedented high flow water volume in Rio Grande River the MRGCD Levee's have sustained damage and are in need of urgent repair in order to prevent major Levee breaches. Which would cause flooding to many residential areas and pose a risk to public safety.

Therefore, MRGCD searched for the closest lowest priced vendor that was responsive and could provide all the material and hauling needed on an immediate urgent basis. Some after hours and emergency on call were required in order to prevent the Levee's from breaking.
