

HELP REDUCE OVERALL MRGCD WATER DEMAND

Sustaining healthy agriculture in the Middle Rio Grande Valley is crucial to maintaining a healthy Rio Grande ecosystem.

ABOUT

The EWLP allows a water user to temporarily lease water back to the District either for a partial or full irrigation season. Following the termination of the lease, participants may immediately irrigate those lands under the normal conditions of a District Water Service Contract.

LEASE PAYMENT RATES

Partial-Season Leases: \$300 per acre; May 1st - August 31st

Full-Season Leases: \$600 per acre; March 1st -October 31st

PURPOSE

The purpose of the EWLP is to reduce overall water demand and increase the flexibility of MRGCD's water resources, helping to balance the need of its various uses.

- ✓ Irrigators are paid per acre that is enrolled in either a Partial or Full Season Lease
- Minimum enrollment of 1 acre; applicants are allowed to enroll multiple tracts to reach 1 total acre (excludes Corrales service area)
- ✓ Must posses a pre-1907 or MRGCD water right to enroll in the program
- Program Enrollment Period: December 17, 2024 February 15, 2025
